# PCCP DIVISION

Resonance launched Pre-foundation Career Care Programs (PCCPs) Division in 2006 with the philosophy of an early start. As the name suggests, the division aims at giving the edge to the students for Career Examinations like JEE (Main + Advanced), NEET/ AIIMS, CA/CS/CLAT etc. before entering into senior secondary classes.

In last 13 years, PCCP division has evolved significantly and works in two segments of classes, namely, Sub-Junior classes (5<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>) and Junior classes (9<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup>). The two segments have different teaching methodologies and so are their targets.

In junior classes, the targeted competitive examinations are National Standard Examination in Junior Science (NSEJS, 1st stage of International Junior Science Olympiad (IJSO)), National Talent Search Examination (NTSE), Pre Regional Mathematics Olympiad (PreRMO, 1st stage of International Mathematics Olympiad). In addition to these competitive examinations, we also prepare students for class 10<sup>th</sup> board examination, according to the latest changes made in it, by exposing them to mock situations like that of the real one.

In Sub-Junior classes, the targeted competitive examinations are National Mathematics Talent Competitions (NMTTC), Private Mathematics and Science Olympiads and other private Olympiads which can be cleared by following CBSE curriculum of the particular class. Other than the competitive examinations, we build conceptual understanding in all the subjects by following NCERT curriculum and conducting various academic workshops to make students understand the application of several concepts.

Other than the academic delivery of concepts in Sub-Junior classes, we also aim at inculcating life skills in students as per the current guidelines of World Health Organization (WHO). The life skills include social skills, thinking skills and emotional skills. These skills are enhanced through a variety of activities conducted at the campus of each study center of Resonance.

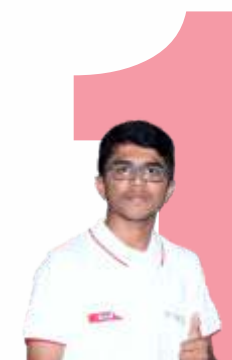

## Pre-defined Yearly Planner

The yearly planner consists of arrayed chapters for each subjects, test grid of whole session with syllabus mentioned in it, holiday schedule, homework checking schedule, etc.



## All India Testing

A mentor is allocated to every student as a mentor seeks to help the student, optimize an educational experience & to assist the student's socialization into a disciplinary culture.



## Motivational Sessions

There is provision of motivational classes within the curriculum which is required to keep the students on track and motivate them to aspire for success. As students of this age require continuous guidance, these motivation sessions help them to set their targets and fix the execution guidelines to achieve them.



## Reso Alert (An app for 360° communication)

Resonance introduced Android Application namely "ResoAlert" which is available on Play Store. ## Parent Teacher & Student Meeting (PTSM)

There is a provision of PTSM which ensures periodic communication among the parents, teachers and students. Through this meeting, parents get feedback about the strengths and weaknesses of their ward and teachers get feedback about their teaching. # CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

A co-curricular activity essentially takes place outside the typical pen & pencil classroom experience. Here, they are purposefully designed for giving an opt combination of students' participation in academics and also making an opportunity for overall growth. The exposure achieved through these activities cannot be achieved alone by theoretical means.

Through activities, we aim to promote life skills. The ten Life Skills can be categorized into three core groups as depicted below:

## LIFE SKILLS



### Thinking Skills

**Self Awareness, Problem Solving, Decision Making, Critical Thinking, Creative Thinking.**

These include decision-making, problem-solving skills and information gathering skills. An individual must be skilled in evaluating the future consequences of their present actions on others. They need to be able to determine alternative solutions and to analyze the influence of their values not only on their own but also on others around them.



### Social Skills

**Interpersonal Relationships, Effective Communication, Empathy.**

These include verbal and non-verbal communication, active listening, and the ability to express feelings and to give feedback. Also this category covers negotiation/refusal skills and assertiveness skills that directly affect one's ability to manage conflicts. Empathy, which is the ability to listen and understand other's needs and problems, is also a key interpersonal skill. Moreover, Team work and the ability to cooperate, express respect for those around us.



### Emotional Skills

**Managing Feelings/ Emotions, Dealing with Stress.**

These refer to skills which help one to increase the internal focus of control over feelings and their expressions, so that the individual can believe that she/he can affect change around and make a difference in the world.

## Workshops: Beyond the horizons of textbooks

The purpose of workshop is to provide a platform for active learning. This learning goes beyond the horizons of textbooks in three ways; higher application of concepts in competitive examinations, nurturing skills acquired over the period of passive learning and applying the concepts through various activities and experiments.

These workshops serve as platform to students for upgrading their knowledge level in a way that increases their ability to perform in different realms.

We offers several types of such workshops throughout the year. Preparation for these exams is quite tough but with perfect guidance, it can be attained easily.

- To take admission in particular Classroom Program & Phase, the students can appear in any two ResoFAST by paying **reappearance fee ₹ 200** & the best of those would be considered for preparing the Final Merit List. His/her roll no. would remain the same for all the tests.
- The ResoFAST result will be declared after 6 days of conduction of exam. It will be announced on our website [www.pccp.resonance.ac.in](http://www.pccp.resonance.ac.in) and also communicated through SMS.
- The decision of Resonance will be final in all the respects and no communication will be entertained.
- Resonance reserves the right to change, or cancel this test at any time, without any prior notice.
- The Application Form Fee paid by student shall not be refunded in any case.

#### Scholarship

- The scholarship is valid for one year only i.e. for academic session: 2020-21 (Availed or Not availed)
- The scholarships shall be applicable to a student only after taking admission in respective program (at Kota/Authorized Study Centre of Resonance across India).
